Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 12 October 2018. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Our response to your request is as follows:

1. *How many items of public rescue equipment (ie Lifebuoys, Lifebelts, Throw Lines or similar) does Greater London Authority maintain at inland or coastal water sites. Excludes Swimming Pools*

- Lifebuoys - 22
- Throw Lines - 3
- Life Jackets - 4

2. *What is the inspection routine for such items?*

- Lifebuoys - depending on location daily or weekly
- Throw line - depending on location daily or weekly
- Life jackets are inspected daily and tested annually.

3. *Who should the public contact to report items missing or damaged?*

For the North Greenwich Pier, to the duty Pier Master.

For the London Sustainability Industries Park, Dagenham please inform the 24 hour security at the entrance to the park.
