Please advise on the number of assaults, attacks, reported crimes in 2015, 2016 and 2017 to day which involved a person or person having a corrosive, acidic, skin-damaging, irritating substance thrown or sprayed onto their head or any part of their body which occurred in the borough of Croydon. For each such instance please advise where known if the assailant(s) knew their victims, how many assailant(s) and how many victim(s) were involved, whether the victim(s) needed hospital treatment if known/contained in the police report. Of these, please advise the number of arrests made and number of subsequent trials, and of any subsequent trials, how many convictions and what the sentencing was. If any part of this request is unclear please contact me for clarification.
