Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 21 January 2020. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000.

Our response to your request is as follows:

1. A yearly breakdown from 1st January 2015 to 31st December 2019 of the number of additional sites built for Gypsies and travellers in your area.

The GLA is not a local authority, however there are no authorised Gypsy and Traveller sites on GLA land.

2. Does your authority have a Gypsy and Traveller Accommodation Need Assessment for new pitches?

The GLA does not undertake such an assessment, this is the responsibility of the local authority that the proposed new pitch is located.

3. What is the need identified by your authority's Gypsy and Traveller Accommodation Need Assessment for new pitches, and what period does this GTANA cover?
