Greenwich Peninsula – Submission of Planning Application

I understand that it is Knight Dragon's intention to submit an outline planning application to the Royal Borough Greenwich on 27th February and although I see no reason why the GLA as land owner should withhold our consent for you to submit I want to place on record at this stage a few areas of concern related to the submission.

Firstly though, I would like to thank you for the work Knight Dragon has done to engage with the GLA and its partners on developing the masterplan and I welcome the receptive and constructive dialogue that we have had with your design team and with other stakeholders through two consultation events. I believe the overall scheme design is now much improved and should result in a high quality development that helps to optimise the use of the location and its long term success.

The two main issues I wish to register relate to affordable housing and the proposed film studio.

The proposed level of affordable housing has been subject to substantial discussion already, but is currently at a level that the GLA does not believe to be adequate or policy compliant. Our planning colleagues will doubtless take this up with you, but rather than hold up the submission of the application I am sure that we can continue to engage in positive dialogue with you and our partners at Royal Borough Greenwich to agree a level and mix of provision that all parties consider appropriate.

The second issue concerns some reservations around the land use distribution set out in the proposals for the film studio. We are keen to gain an early and better understanding of the impact this has on the wider viability of the scheme and the options for an alternative use should the film studio concept prove unsustainable. Thus far we have not had sight of your detailed appraisal for the studio and although we see real value in the ambition to bring an international standard of facility to the Peninsula, we need to understand when, whether, how, and on what basis such a proposition can be delivered.

It would be very helpful if you could share your technical advice on the proposals at the earliest opportunity and we would suggest that consideration should be given to seeking flexibility around a possible change of use for the land in the longer term should a film studio prove to be a facility that cannot be delivered on a sensible commercial basis.

I should also add that the proposed film studio's low development density, and location on GLA owned land, would significantly limit the level of land receipt due to the GLA relative to the value of the wider scheme. I know that Simon Powell and Will Stewart have raised this with your team and I would want some further discussion on this point to ensure that the GLA and wider public sector commercial interests are adequately reflected in the final scheme.

You will, of course, appreciate that nothing in this letter should be taken to represent the view of GLA planning officers or the Mayor in their statutory planning roles which will, of course, follow a separate and independent process.

I look forward to continuing to work with you on these points over the coming weeks and we can perhaps pick up some of them when we meet with Royal Borough Greenwich next week.


