Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 13 June 2018. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

*How many vehicles are registered to addresses within the proposed new ULEZ. Of those vehicles, how many are not compliant and therefore will have to pay a daily charge of £12.50?*

In Inner the London there are approximately:

- 650,000 car owning households;
- 700,000 to 800,000 cars associated with these households.
- Compliance is currently around 40%;
- Compliance in 2021 without the new ULEZ is likely to be 75% to 80%;

You may also be interested in information published by Transport for London as part of the ULEZ consultation. TfL is the Mayor's transport authority and is responsible for implementing the Mayor's Transport Strategy.
