Thank you for your request for information. Transport for London (TfL) have produced the dataset in question. I've checked with them to see if they hold the information to be able to respond to your request before referring you to them however they have informed me that currently they are unable to show taxi and private hire vehicles separately in their database ACCSTATS. The vehicle category designated by the Department for Transport combines taxi and private hire vehicles into one category shown as Taxi.

During 2007, 2008 and part of 2009 the Metropolitan Police introduced a different collision recording database that enabled the three vehicle types 06 Private Hire - Licensed, 07 Private Hire - Unlicensed and 08 - Taxi to be recorded, however after these dates the newer system was withdrawn and the previous one reinstated. Where recorded these are shown in the 2007, 2008 and 2009 vehicle data extract files.

The Metropolitan Police have introduced a new recording application for road traffic collisions and TfL have requested that taxi and private hire be recorded separately (though they will still be combined in the national data set), they hope to show these two vehicle types in the future.
