2. Business Continuity

MOPAC discussed virtual visits and asked Chairs to indicate if there was any desire on their panels to return to physical visits.

Members also discussed training and upskilling required to support ICVs with virtual work and technology.

MOPAC detailed the recruitment needs of the scheme and urgent cover support required for specific panels.

Members discussed the Risk Reduction Framework documents and specifically the COVID Age assessment forms.

MOPAC updated panels on the development of the Mayor's Action Plan for Trust and Accountability in Policing [working title], which will include the introduction of a new custody record dip sampling process. MOPAC expects to roll out training to ICVs ahead of the pilot of the scheme in Spring 2021.

Virtual Visits

MOPAC have created a checklist for MPS and ICVs to complete during virtual visits and revised reporting prompt sheets are being drafted and will be circulated shortly. MOPAC confirmed that virtual practices – panel meetings and virtual visits will remain in place in until Summer 2021.

ICVs were reminded that at the start of the virtual visit they should identify the number of detainees who are juveniles and to ensure they note any who have been subject to strip search.

Members discussed recruitment needs across the Scheme and MOPAC advised that recruitment would be resumed as soon as reasonably practicable given the pandemic.
