Mayoral Delegation to Transport for London, the London Legacy Development Corporation and the Old Oak and Park Royal Development Corporation in respect of the Greater London Authority Group Responsible Procurement Policy

BACKGROUND

- 1. The Mayor has been asked to approve an updated Greater London Authority Group Responsible Procurement Policy to be known as the Responsible Procurement Policy ('RPP').
- The RPP is a high level strategic document setting out the Greater London Authority Group's plans, ambitions and commitments for ensuring continuous improvement in London delivered through all of its procurement activities and, in respect of certain functional bodies, its financial assistance programmes. In addition to each of its functional bodies, the RPP is also supported by the Metropolitan Police Service.
- 3. In order for Transport for London ('TfL'), the London Legacy Development Corporation ('LLDC') and the Old Oak and Royal Park Development Corporation ('OPDC') to be able to implement the RPP in full, including preparing and fulfilling action plans and meeting key performance indicators, it is considered prudent for the Mayor to delegate his powers under sections 30 and 34 of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 ('GLA Act') to these bodies subject to the conditions specified below.

DELEGATION

I hereby authorise TfL, LLDC and OPDC under section 38(1) of the GLA Act to exercise the Mayor's powers under sections 30 and 34 of the GLA Act for the purpose of doing all things reasonably necessary to facilitate compliance with the RPP when taking procurement decisions and granting financial assistance and to take any other action they consider reasonably necessary for the purpose of implementing the RPP subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS OF DELEGATION

- In exercising the Mayor's power under sections 30 and 34 of the Act pursuant to this Delegation, TfL, LLDC and OPDC shall generally comply with any directions or guidance issued by me or any instructions issued by any officer I nominate to act on my behalf in relation to this Delegation; and
- 2. TfL, LLDC and OPDC shall at all times afford to the GLA's Monitoring Officer all reasonable cooperation and access to such documents and facilities as may be reasonably required from time to time in respect of that person's functions under section 5(2) of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989.
