Since the 8th December 2020 (the date of the first vaccine for Covid-19 being administered) -

How many assaults against NHS staff and volunteers administering the vaccines have been reported to the Metropolitan Police (including all verbal and non-physical assaults)?

How many incidents of anti-vaccination aggression, violence and unlawful activity has been reported to the Metropolitan Police during the same period?

Has the Metropolitan Police received any reports/complaints with regard to anyone being abused and/or assaulted as a result of their views on Covid-19 vaccinations?

If so, would you please supply information (if held) on any offences committed by persons who could be described as anti-vaccination.

And, please supply information (if held) on any offences committed against persons who could be described as anti-vaccination.
