Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 2 March 2020. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000.

You asked for a list of how many residential buildings with aluminium composite material (ACM) cladding there are in the local authority area and further details on each of those buildings.

Our response to your request is as follows:

The Ministry for Communities, Housing and Local Government (MCHLG) is responsible for collecting data on buildings affected by ACM cladding, and the information they collect is published in building safety data releases, the latest of which is available on the link below¹. Specific information on exact number of buildings in each borough, or how many have received cladding remediation funding, is not published to avoid the risk that buildings can be identified.
