Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 23 June 2021. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for:

- 1) *Please provide any correspondence between the Mayor's Office and the Innotech Network regarding the Greater London Authority's Super Connected Cities scheme between 2013 to 2015.*
- 2) *Please can you confirm:*
  - a. *whether the Innotech Network was awarded vouchers as part of the Greater London Authority's Super Connected Cities scheme?*
  - b. *and if so, what the value of these vouchers were?*

Our response to your request is as follows:

The information that the GLA holds within scope of your request has been published on our FOI disclosure Log (See page 175 of the response):

The named applicant started an application for a voucher on 16/10/2014. However, they never completed the application as they didn't provide full information (e.g. quotes/claim amount) and therefore the SCCP team did not assess the application.

To summarise, the GLA did not fund Innotech Networks to support subsidies against a broadband connection. If the application had been successful, it would have been transferred to the broadband supplier and not the applicant.
