Our response to your request is as follows:

The information you have requested is available via the GLA spending reports¹.

- £15,000 – Thamesmead & Abbey Wood OAPF Commonplace
- £18,000 – Royal Docks & Beckton Riverside OAPF Commonplace

The GLA don't pay VAT so these figures are not inclusive of VAT.

The contracts were awarded through Single Source Supplier Justification, which was approved in July 2019.
