Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 7 May 2020. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for the following information:

... how many bedrooms each applicant had who successfully moved through the Seaside Country Homes Scheme, going back to 2013 up to the present day? For instance I already know that in 2019 there were 150 lets altogether through the SCH scheme, and I know that two Brent tenants moved through the scheme that year. I would like to know by borough, for each year since 2013, how many bedrooms each applicant had who moved.

Our response to your request is as follows:

We have provided this data in the attached spreadsheet. Please note that those listed as SCH Clearing House are move on applicants who are offered the opportunity to move through the scheme only when there are no remaining applicants willing to consider the property in question.
