In exercise of the power conferred upon me by section 328A (1) of the Greater London Authority Act 1999, and having regard to the Fire and Rescue National Framework prepared under section 21 of the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004, and fire safety enforcement guidance under article 26 of the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005, I hereby direct the London Fire and Emergency Planning Authority (LFEPA) as follows:

Disposal of nine of its former fire stations

- In relation to the sale by LFEPA of the nine of its former fire stations at Belsize, Bow, Clerkenwell, Downham, Kingsland, Silvertown, Southwark, Westminster and Woolwich, to report to the Mayor of London with all available information on the bids submitted to LFEPA within twelve weeks of their receipt.
- 2. To await the Mayor of London's response before entering into any agreements to dispose of the nine former fire stations referred to in (1.) above.
