Can you please supply me with a copy of the minutes of all meetings at which MOPAC discussed the College of Policing's Fundamental Review (launched in 2021) with the College?

RESPONSE

Thank you for your Freedom of Information (FOI) request of 1 March to the Mayor's Office for Policing And Crime (MOPAC). I confirm that your request has been handled under the FOI Act 2000 and that MOPAC does hold some information related to your request.

There were no formal written minutes taken at the meetings between MOPAC and the College of Policing when the College of Policing Review was discussed.

However, there was an informal follow up email sent on 24 January 2022 after a meeting, the relevant extract of which is below:

College of Policing Review

Due to be published shortly. Contents have been trailed to PCC's and Chief's. Broadly welcomed. The challenge is that people wanted the College to do more, to do it better, while resources are being reduced.

CEO refocusing work on priorities such as VAWG, inclusion, suppressing homicide, Soteria/Bluestone, and trust and confidence. The College wants to work with MOPAC on these areas, will share and involve. Keen to develop secondments into these areas.

Will also work more closely with OPCC's.

Work on leadership is gathering pace.
