## 1. Fees required

### 1.1. Cost and valuation consultants

GLAP has worked with its existing consultants LSH and Temple to clarify the additional fees required to spend on the project at each drawdown. Both consultants have reviewed their scope and the likely fees incurred on the project.

The total fees for a single drawdown will now total £10,000 for Temple and £7,000 for LSH with the additional tasks included. Therefore to cover the next three drawdowns which should follow

the same template a total of £51,000 is requested. After two further drawdowns the fees will be reviewed again to ascertain if savings can be made.

# 1.2. <u>Legal</u>

GLAP's retained solicitor on the project is Eversheds and there has been significant work required to address the Section 106 and Section 278 agreements on both Beam Reach 5 and Jenkins Lane. As a result the legal fees need to increase by a further £10,000 to cover the next three land drawdowns.
