

REQUEST

I am writing to make a request for all the information to which I am entitled. Please send to me all records of information on the news story linked to below which allege, or prove, that the aforementioned news story is factually incorrect.

I would like the above information to be provided to me as electronic copies, paper copies, audiotape versions, or an opportunity to view.

If this request is too wide or unclear, I would be grateful if you could contact me for clarification. If any of this information is already in the public domain, please can you direct me to it, with page references and URLs if necessary.

If the release of any of this information is prohibited on the grounds of breach of confidence, I ask that you supply me with copies of the confidentiality agreement and remind you that information should not be treated as confidential if such an agreement has not been signed. In cases where a requested document contains some exempt information, only those specified pieces of exempt information can be withheld and the rest of the document has to be released. It should be noted that absolute/qualified exemptions do not necessarily apply in all and every circumstance.

It should also be noted that it is an offence for any officer or employee of an authority to alter, deface, block, erase, destroy or conceal records (or any part thereof) held by an authority with the intention of preventing their disclosure to an applicant who has requested the information.
