Please could I have a copy of any Police Crime Commissioner (PCC) reports produced relating to the Metropolitan Police force's use of mobile phone data extraction technology between 01/01/2019 and the present day (20/07/2021).

RESPONSE

Thank you for your Freedom of Information request of 20 July to the Mayor's Office for Policing And Crime (MOPAC). I confirm that your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and that MOPAC does hold information relating to your request. However, this information is exempt from disclosure under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act, since it is information which is already published.

Section 21 is an absolute exemption which means there is no requirement to carry out a public interest test if the requested information is exempt. Please see links below:
