Request for information pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Boris Johnson's emails relating to the subject of the EU and the EU referendum

I would like to request copies of Boris Johnson's email correspondence on the subject of the EU, as an institution, and the EU referendum.

Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act (FoIA) and we can today provide you with our formal response to your request. Please find enclosed with this letter copies of the information that our searches have identified as being in-scope of your request which we can disclose to you in full.

We have made a number of minor redactions to remove some personal data under the exemption provisions of section 40(2) of the Act where we believe that the disclosure of that third-party personal data would be neither fair nor lawful in respect of those individuals.
