Thank you for your further correspondence which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 22 August 2020. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

You asked for:

Please provide all information concerning or relating to Miraj (GB) Ltd developers, their directors as Aziz Rahman and Fazal Daulatzal, their agents, contractors, other Authorities having any connection with Miraj (GB) Ltd or its directors.

In whatsoever format, to or form, to include but not limited to plans, reports, internal documentation, emails, notes, letters, agents, services, other authorities, building control companies, councillors, members of the public.

I also wish to establish if this company or its directors have previously submitted plans or have been granted approval for any plans, information / data in whatsoever format received, notifications or complaints from whatsoever source, so please include this aspect when checking for information/ data.

I would be happy to restrict the search to just the planning Dept. You surely must have a database you are able to search for names or address which would limit the search time and area.

Our response to your request is as follows:

We have undertaken a search of our planning database which contains the strategic planning applications that have been referred to the Mayor since 2012. Please note that our system does not record applicant names, however we are able to search by company. I can confirm that a search was completed for Miraj and there was no information held on the system by that organisation.

Please note that the GLA is London's strategic government and does not operate in the same way as local Borough Councils. The GLA planning team is therefore responsible for the applications referred
