*As you will know, under the Mayor of London Order 2008 the Mayor of London must be consulted on all planning applications that are of strategic importance to London.*

*Please take this email as a formal request of information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 for a list of (and all of) the approved planning applications for residential and mixed use developments*

*approved by the Mayor of London office where a centralised heating system or district heating system has been included in the property since the establishment of the London Plan.*

### **The Greater London Authority's response sent 2 June 2016**

The Mayor is a statutory consultee for most applications referred under the Mayor of London Order, except for applications where the Mayor has decided to call-in an application, therefore becoming the local planning authority. As the Mayor is a statutory consultee for most applications we do not record the information that you asked for. The various London Boroughs should be able to answer your query.

In total there have been 19 applications that have been called-in, 17 of which have been granted approval. All information on these 19 applications is publically available including whether a centralised heating system or district heating system is included.
