

Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 9 February 2018. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Our response to your request is as follows;

1. The level of funding by the authority for the provision of women's refuges within it jurisdiction in the following financial years (2010/2011 - 2017/2018)

It is not a function of the GLA to provide revenue funding for these services. The GLA is London's strategic government and does not operate in the same way London's local authorities, the Borough Councils.

The GLA can and has provided capital funds for refurbishment or development of new accommodation for victims of domestic violence. The GLA provided the following capital funding where the grant was solely to house people at risk of domestic violence. We do not capture information where there are multiple intended client groups within a single scheme.

2013/14 financial year: £1,895,010

Throughout the time periods requested the GLA has been open to receive capital funding bids from Registered Housing Associations for this type of provision, and we continue to welcome bids in future.

2. The number of women's refuges within the authority's jurisdiction in the following financial years (2010/2011 - 2017/2018)

The GLA does not hold this information. However, the <u>London Boroughs</u> may hold this information for their areas. Alternatively, <u>London Councils</u> may hold information.
