Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 3 January 2019. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act (2000)

Please note that the GLA is London's strategic government and does not operate in the same way as London's Borough Councils, including the City of London (listed at https://www.london.gov.uk/in-my-area). Unlike the Boroughs we are not responsible for parks and highways. However, we are responsible for Trafalgar Square, Parliament Square and some land and property holdings.

The GLA's contractor for the squares has confirmed that no chemical weed killer is used either for the cleansing or the ground maintenance services of the square. Trafalgar Square is not a green space.
