Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 30 December 2016. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for:

....all correspondence in respect the Cycle Super Highway 11 which has emanated from the Mayor personally.

I can confirm that the GLA does hold some information relevant to your request. This information is attached.

Please note that some personal information is exempt from disclosure under s.40 (Personal information) of the Freedom of Information Act. This information identifies an individual and as such constitutes as personal data which is defined by s.1 (1) of the Data Protection Act 1998 to mean data which relates to a living individual who can be identified from that data.

It is considered that disclosure of this information would contravene the first data protection principle which states that "Personal data shall be processed fairly and lawfully and, in particular, shall not be processed unless -

*"(a) at least one of the conditions in Schedule 2 is met, and
(b) in the case of sensitive personal data, at least one of the conditions in Schedule 3 is also met."*

It is considered that none of the conditions allow the processing of the information apply in this case as the subject has not consented to the use of their data for an alternative purpose (namely disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act).
