

Dear Resident.

We wrote to you on Friday 21 November to explain that there would be no changes to your tenancy until we have had the opportunity to talk to you in the New Year.

We are writing today to provide some further reassurance: whatever decisions we make following the discussions we have with you and local stakeholders in early 2015, there will be no changes to tenancy agreements and no increase in rents during the first half of 2015.

Furthermore, to help us work with you more closely we will also be appointing a dedicated tenant liaison officer and are in the late stages of this process. As soon as this person is appointed, we will introduce them to you.

In the meantime, we continue to work closely with local stakeholders. Since we last wrote to you, we have had further conversations with Meg Hillier MP, Deputy Mayor of London Richard Blakeway and Councillor Philip Glanville.

We understand that the accusations about us and our plans for the Estate may have caused concern and distress amongst tenants, so we hope that these commitments provide some further reassurance.
