Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 3 December 2020. Your request has been dealt with under the Environmental Information Regulations (EIR) 2004.

You asked for;

- 1. How many applications were received for the Mayor Of London's Grow Back Greener Fund (i.e eligible and ineligible)*
- 2. How many applications were received for the Mayor Of London's Grow Back Greener Fund from Barnet borough (i.e eligible and ineligible)*
- 3. Who applied for the Mayor Of London's Grow Back Greener Fund (i.e list of organisations / constituted groups) in Barnet borough*

Our response to your request is as follows:

1. 197 applications were received for the Grow Back Greener Fund. 194 of these applications were eligible for consideration by the fund.
2. 9 applications were received for projects located in the London Borough of Barnet. All of these applications were eligible for consideration by the fund.
3. The following organisations submitted applications for projects in the London Borough of Barnet:
