Thank you for your request for information about money spent on the YouGov poll on the possible transfer of control of the South Eastern rail network from the Department for Transport to TfL. We received your request on 3 January and it has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The Director Decision 'DD2042: Periodic Polling Programme' signed in September 2016 approved the commission of a market research agency to provide periodic online polling of Greater London residents for 12 months. Following this procurement process, YouGov Plc were contracted to undertake this work. The Director approved expenditure of up to £130K.
