Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 24st November 2017. Your request has been dealt with under the [Freedom of Information Act 2000/Environmental Information Regulations 2004].

You asked for:

I am writing to request a list of Major Residential developments (150+ units) that have been granted planning permission in London following the Housing Supplementary Planning Guidance (SPG) published in March 2016 (so from 01/03/16 to present), and their status (incomplete/complete - if latter when).

This information is ultimately already on the London Development Database, but there doesn't seem to be a way of searching for it other than trawling across the map for every square 1000m."

Our response to your request is as follows:

Please find attached a list of planning approvals proposing 150 units or more since 01/03/2016 from the London Development Database (LDD). The list includes all schemes so far submitted to the LDD by London's planning authorities along with approval, start and completion dates for each scheme where known. Please note that the London boroughs have three months from the end of each month to submit planning approvals and that details of scheme starts and completions are only required by the end of August each year. This means that the starts and completions from 1st April 2017 onwards are only due for submission by the end of August 2018. Where the data has already been provided by the planning authority, this data is included in the report.

A list of live permissions and completions back to 2006 can be found on the London Datastore.
