Please find attached the information we hold within the scope of your request:

In 2017 London had:

- 505,655 enterprises
- 566,715 local units/workplaces

Notes:

The source is ONS (2017) <u>UK business; activity, size and location: 2017</u>. This data covers businesses registered with HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC) for Value Added Tax (VAT) and/or Pay-As-You-Earn (PAYE). The figures are for businesses at both Enterprise and Local Unit level.

- An **enterprise** is the smallest combination of legal units (generally based on VAT and/or PAYE records) which has a certain degree of autonomy within an enterprise group.
- An individual site (for example a factory or shop) in an enterprise is called a **local unit** or **workplace**.
