This data was not produced when preparing the GLA's BAME Pay Gap Report. However, we have been able to produce it in answer your request.

BAME women compared to both white men and women

White Women v BAME women (Mean)	9.38%
White Women v BAME women (Median)	6.89%
White Men v BAME women (Mean)	19.05%
White Men v BAME women (Median)	11.49%

Action planning

Our 2019 ethnicity pay gap action plan has been developed in collaboration with the GLA's BAME staff network, Unison, all GLA staff and other stakeholders and has been endorsed by the GLA's Diversity and Inclusion Management Board led by the Chief Officer and which oversees all internal workforce diversity activity. In developing the action plan issues relating to the intersection of gender, colour, race and ethnicity were discussed and considered as part of the process.
