I can confirm that your request has been being handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and that MOPAC does hold some information relating to your request, which is set out below.

The majority of the budget that is apportioned to Redbridge is given directly to the local authority who then makes local commissioning decisions independent of MOPAC. However, MOPAC do directly commission several small projects in the borough and also provide Pan London services which deliver in Redbridge.
