

## Trussell Trust Food Banks End Of Year Figures - London

Between 1st April 2018 and 31st March 2019, 1,583,668 three day emergency food supplies were provided to people in crisis by food banks in the Trussell Trust network. During this period, 166,512 three day emergency food supplies were provided to people in London.
