1. What was the total police precept for 2021?
2. What is the expected total police precept for 2022?

## RESPONSE

Thank you for your Freedom of Information (FOI) request of 19 January to the Mayor's Office for Policing And Crime (MOPAC). I confirm that MOPAC does hold information relating to your request; please see responses below:

1. What was the total police precept for 2021?

The total policing element of the Mayor's precept for 2021-22 is £267.13 for a typical Band D property.

2. What is the expected total police precept for 2022?

The Mayor's draft budget proposals published on 18 January (see link below) confirm his current council tax proposals for 2022-23, albeit these will not be confirmed until his final draft budget is considered by the London Assembly at its plenary meeting on 24 February. At this stage, the Mayor's proposed police precept for 2022-23 is £277.13 – a £10 increase compared to 2021-22.
