Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 28 October 2017. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested the figures for the total value of community infrastructure levies received by the GLA annually from 2008 until 2017.

The Mayor commenced MCIL (Mayoral CIL) charging on 1 April 2012. The amount of MCIL money collected by each borough on behalf of the Mayor is recorded in line with Regulation 62 of the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2010 (as amended).

The amount of CIL transferred to Transport for London (TfL) by borough is shown in the document below. This includes the amount taken in administrative fees by the boroughs and by TfL:
