Please find below the GLA's spend on Occupational Health between 2015 and 2019 and in 2020.

The GLA's Occupational Health provider is Transport for London, who are part of the GLA Group. Since 2018/19 their charge for the provision of Occupational Health services has been based on an annual fee, before then, it was on a case by case basis. This charge is by financial year. Therefore, the figures below are from 1 April to 31 March each year.
