For ESF, London's share of the national programme budget for 2014-20 is £422,254,073 (funding is awarded by Government in euros so this figure is subject to exchange rate fluctuations). Of the total allocation for ESF, £316,690,555 is allocated to Priority Axis 1 - Inclusive Labour Markets and £105,563,518 is allocated to Priority Axis 2 - Skills for Growth. In addition, London has received an allocation of £33,376,798 under the Youth Employment Initiative (YEI). No funding has been awarded to date under the YEI.

No ESF/ERDF has been drawn down/provided to the organisations to date. We do not hold data for projects' set-up costs. Running costs are indicated by the ESF/ERDF grant awarded in arrears over the projects' delivery period.

As Government is responsible for ESF and ERDF in England, it is placed to make funding decisions post-2020. Clearly the EU Referendum outcome will affect this; likewise, local decisions made by projects about their own future funding.
