THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL DEVELOPMENT PROCEDURE) ORDER 1995 DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLES 10 AND 27 RELATING TO MURPHY'S WHARF

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions in exercise of the powers conferred on him by articles 10(3) and 27 of the Town and Country Planning (General Development Procedure) Order 1995 (a) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby directs the Council of the London Borough of Greenwich as follows:-

- 1. In this Direction-
 - "Council" means the Council of the London Borough of Greenwich;
 - "Mayor" means the Mayor of London; and
 - "Mayor of London Order" means the Town and Country Planning (Mayor of London) Order 2000 (b).
- 2. (1) This Direction shall come into force on 3 July 2000 and, subject to sub-paragraph (2) below, shall apply to any application for planning permission for development which is received by the Council on or after 3 July 2000 and which is for development wholly or partly within the area edged in red on the attached plan.
 - (2) This Direction does not apply to any application for planning permission to which paragraph 1(2) of the Schedule to the Mayor of London Order applies.
- 3. Before granting planning permission on any application to which this Direction applies, the Council shall consult the Mayor.
- 4. (1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2) below, the Directions given to the Council of the London Borough of Greenwich by the Secretary of State on 8 January 1999 under articles 10(3) and 14(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Development Procedure) Order 1995 relating to Brewery Wharf, Granite Wharf, Tunnel Glucose, Delta Wharf, Angerstein Wharf, Murphy's Wharf, Lovell's Wharf, Victoria Deep Water Terminal, Ordnance Wharf and Riverside Wharf are hereby cancelled, in so far as they relate to Murphy's Wharf.
 - (2) Sub-paragraph (1) does not apply to any application for planning permission-
 - (a) which is received by the Council on or before 2 July 2000, or
 - (b) to which paragraph 1(2) of the Schedule to the Mayor of London Order applies.
