Dear Sian,

Thank you for your letter of 4 August setting out the views of the London Assembly Transport Committee on my proposals to expand the Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ) London-wide in 2023 and amend the Mayor's Transport Strategy (MTS).

I note that you have also sent your response to Transport for London (TfL). TfL is now collating and analysing all responses to the consultation. It will then prepare a report identifying key issues and themes and any recommended modifications to the proposals in light of responses received and included as part of the consultation. I will decide on whether to proceed with my proposals, with or without modifications, after considering this report.

You will be aware that, should I decide to proceed with the proposed amendments to the MTS, the final proposed text will be laid before the London Assembly for review in advance of their publication. If the Assembly does not reject them and following the publication of the revised MTS, TfL will proceed to make the ULEZ Variation Order and submit it to me for confirmation. I will decide whether or not to confirm the Order after taking into account consultation responses and other relevant matters. A post-adoption statement related to the strategic environmental assessment of the MTS revisions will also be published.
