

### 2022-23 Domestic Abuse Safe Accommodation and Support - Continuation and Contractual Awards

Further to the new duties under Part 4 of the Domestic Abuse Act 2021, the Mayor has commissioned a range of services to meet the safe accommodation needs of domestic abuse survivors and their children. A full list of services can be found below, along with the amount awarded for 2022-23. There are two types of funding listed - continuation grants, which were services previously funded by the Department of Levelling Up, Housing and Communities and continues to be funded by the GLA, and - call off contracts, services that have been commissioned by the GLA from an approved framework of providers.
