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- 5.3 During the course of the discussion, the Committee requested the following further information in writing from TfL:
 - Details of the proposed 'bus stop bypass' outside St Thomas' Hospital and how the impact on sight impaired patients was being taken into account;
 - The reasons for some seats for disabled people on buses having no space underneath for an assistance dog;
 - Further details about enforcement of private hire licensing in connection with refusing to pick up customers with an assistance dog, including the number of such incidents, what the TfL policy about enforcement is; and
 - What proof private drivers were required to provide where they claimed to have a dog allergy in order to be exempt from being required to pick up a customer with an assistance dog.
