A timescale for the community monitoring pilots taking place in five London boroughs.

Work has begun on implementing the recommendations of the local scrutiny review, with the pilot steering group meeting monthly and an MOU for the new framework agreed by the group. It is anticipated that a new way of working will be in operation in pilot boroughs by the autumn, and this work will be incorporated into the wider Community Engagement review led by Black Thrive Global CIC. Recommendations for a more representative and accountable pan-London framework of community engagement and scrutiny are expected in November.
