The meeting will start at 10.00am, but the Confirmation Hearing will not commence until 11.45am and therefore your attendance will be required from 11.30am. The meeting will take place in the Chamber at City Hall, and will be held in public.

Jeff Jacobs, as the Authority's Head of Paid Service, has issued a statutory notice in relation to this meeting to you (attached).

At its meeting on 22 May 2012, the Police and Crime Committee also resolved to request that you, in advance of the meeting, provide an updated CV and any information which you consider relevant and would be of interest to the Committee, in relation to your appointment to this office. Please note that any information provided will be made public. (Information under Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972 is only exempt from publication if and so long as, in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.)

Please note that questions and supplementary questions to you will cover the following areas:

- whether the candidate is qualified for the position;
- whether the candidate has the time and capacity for the position;
- whether the candidate is fit (independent & impartial) for the position;
- key responsibilities and issues for the Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime for the future.

Please note also that at the agenda's standing item *Declarations of Interests* the Chair may invite you to declare any relevant interests in terms of the business of the meeting and regarding the (proposed) appointment.
