3.1 At the Committee's meeting of 29 January 2013, it was proposed that the Committee receive quarterly updates on the progress of the Mayor's Mentoring Programme.

4. Issues for Consideration

4.1 The Mayor's Mentoring Programme aims to provide mentoring for 1,000 young black boys (10-16 years - in targeted London boroughs) who are at risk of offending, committing anti-social behaviour or from disengaging with education, employment and training.

4.2 An update on the programme is attached as **Appendix 1** and in attendance at the meeting to discuss the programme will be the Assistant Director of Health and Communities.
