1. Summary

- 1.1 This report outlines recent action taken by the Chairman of the Police and Crime Committee in accordance with the delegated authority granted to him by the Police and Crime Committee at its meeting on 9 March 2017.

2. Recommendation

- 2.1 **That the Committee notes the recent action taken by the Chairman of the Police and Crime Committee under delegated authority, following consultation with the party Group Lead Members and Caroline Pidgeon MBE AM, namely to agree the arrangements for the Committee's site visit to the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park on 20 September 2017.**

3. Background

- 3.1 At its meeting on 9 March 2017, the Police and Crime Committee resolved:

That authority be delegated to the Chairman, in consultation with the party Group Lead Members and Caroline Pidgeon MBE AM to agree arrangements for a site visit to the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park to observe policing in and around the Park.

- 3.2 Following consultation, the site visit was arranged for 20 September 2017. Members received a briefing from officers of the London Legacy Development Corporation and its external partners and then toured the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park and its surroundings in order to be informed about the policing and security issues in and around the park.

4. Issues for Consideration

- 4.1 The Committee is recommended to note that a site visit to the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park took place on 20 September 2017.
