Thursday 23 February 2012	Consideration of the Draft Policing London Business Plan 2012-15
Thursday 8 March 2012	Question and answer session with the Deputy Mayor for Policing and the Deputy Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis followed by a discussion about the MPS' new stop and search policy.
