The annual Housing in London report is the evidence base for the Mayor's housing policies, summarising key patterns and trends across a wide range of topics relevant to housing in the capital. The report informs the development of the Mayor's London Housing Strategy, the latest edition of which was published in May 2018.

Housing in London 2021 includes sections on London Housing Strategy monitoring and key statistics for London boroughs and is divided into five core thematic chapters:

- 1. Demographic, economic and housing context

- 4. Housing needs, including homelessness and overcrowding
- 5. Mobility and decent homes
