The London Assembly **Police and Crime Committee** will hold one-off fact finding meeting focussing on the Metropolitan Police (the Met) Territorial Support Group (TSG).

Meeting aims and objectives (Terms of Reference)

- The make-up and headcount of the TSG
- How and where the TSG is deployed
- Community oversight and scrutiny arrangements for the TSG
- How the TSG is resourced and do TSG officers have confidence to use their powers when required

Key questions

- How is the TSG deployed?
- How are the TSG's operations monitored and scrutinised?

- Is the TSG the right response to the issues facing Londoners?
- How does community feedback for use of the TSG work in practice?
- Is the TSG adequately resourced?
