1. DLUHC Consultation Response

The London Assembly Fire, Resilience and Emergency Planning (FREP) Committee has **today** responded to the Department for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities (DLUHC)'s consultation on sprinklers in care homes, removal of national classes, and staircases in residential homes.
