1. London Ambulance Service Letter to Mayor

Following a visit by the **London Assembly Health Committee** to the London Ambulance Service Dockside Education Centre and Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) Newham on 24 January 2023, the Committee has written to the Mayor of London with **three** recommendations on how the Mayor can support the London Ambulance Service.

Recommendations within the letter include:

- The Mayor should work with LAS, NHS London and the five Integrated care systems (ICSs) to explore options for a more simplified London-wide governance structure for LAS.
- The Mayor should explore opening up the GLA Green Bond Programme to organisations such as LAS to allow for retrofitting of their estate.
- The Mayor should work with LAS on public awareness campaigns to educate Londoners on correct usage of the 999 emergency service.
