The London TravelWatch Business Plan for 2020/21 sets out details for a new partnership with Transport Focus, with the introduction of new senior management arrangements including the establishment of a new London TravelWatch Director role. The advert for this position was published in October with an interview date set for 2 December. Following this, the Government announced that a General Election would be held on 12 December and, as such, all London Assembly meetings were postponed.

At the London Assembly (Plenary) meeting on 31 October 2019, the Assembly agreed, in relation to urgent matters only, a general delegation of authority in respect of the Assembly's powers and functions (apart from those that cannot under the Greater London Authority Act 1999 be delegated) be given to the Chair of the Assembly, in consultation with the Deputy Chairman, party Group Leaders and relevant Committee Chair(s), from the close of the meeting up until the General Election scheduled for 12th December 2019.

Under the GLA Act, officer appointments to London TravelWatch are subject to approval by the London Assembly. Noting the change in working arrangements with Transport Focus and the seniority of the position, the Deputy Chair of the Transport Committee was invited to sit on the recruitment panel for this position.

Following consultation with the Deputy Chairman, party Group Lead Members and the Chair of the Transport Committee, the Chair of the Assembly agreed to delegate authority for the Deputy Chair of the Transport Committee to sit on the recruitment panel for this position.

The outcome of this recruitment process will be reported back to the Transport Committee, which would ordinarily consider issues related to London TravelWatch, at its next suitable meeting.
